

Direct Financial Assistance Program

The Direct Financial Assistance Program provides financial assistance to members who are experiencing a financial hardship. **This program should be utilized as a last resort.** Applicants must show other efforts were made to resolve current financial hardship; i.e, contact with Hemophilia Treatment Center Social Worker, contact to electrical company, and/or contact to social services. Assistance under the Direct Financial Assistance Program includes:

- Transportation to and from the treatment center (gas money, parking fees)
- Utilities: gas, water, electricity
- Co-pays deductibles or otherwise uncovered pharmaceutical or medical services

Only one request can be made per calendar year.
